2. This Office reiterates DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017, "Guidelines on the Conduct of Off-Campus Activities," that emphasizes the importance of adhering to strict safety and security protocols for all participants before, during, and after the activity.

3. All schools shall conduct thorough risk assessments and prepare comprehensive safety plans covering transportation to and from the venue. These plans should include emergency contact information, designated meeting points, and procedures for handling unforeseen circumstances. Designated teachers and chaperones must provide constant supervision. Parental/guardian consent forms are also required for all student participants.

4. Strict adherence to these protocols is paramount to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all participants. Non-compliance may result to disciplinary action.
