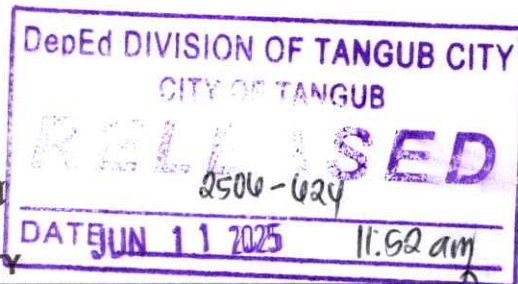

SUBMISSION OF CLASS PROGRAM AND TEACHER LOADING
FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MATATAG
AND THE REVISED K TO 12 CURRICULA

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

Public and Private Schools

1. To support the effective implementation of DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2024 and DepEd Order No. 012, s. 2024 which provides guidelines on the implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum and the Revised K to 12 Curriculum, this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) issues prototype class programming and teacher loading for schools to serve as ready reference in the finalization of class programs and assignment of teacher's teaching loads.

3. All schools are required to submit their Class Program and Teacher Loading on **June 13, 2025** to the Office of the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) for review and endorsement for signature of the Schools Division Superintendent.
4. Schools are given the flexibility in the implementation of the curriculum in consideration of their specific context but not limited to the type and size of school, curricular program offerings, and the availability of teachers and classrooms. The number of minutes per day and time allotment is stated in Item 2 of DepEd Order 012, s. 2024 titled Amendment to DepEd Order No. 010, s. 2024.
5. In the event of a declaration of suspension or cancellation of in-person classes by authorized offices due to emergencies and hazards as stipulated in DO 22, s. 2024, Revised Guidelines on Class and Work Suspension in Schools During Disasters and Emergencies, schools and CLCs shall automatically



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
implement the ADM, utilizing the modules distributed to schools. Activities provided to learners shall commensurate the number of hours specified in the Class Program.

6. For unforeseen call ups for any DepEd-related activities, the learning areas affected in the schedule of classes must not be compromised. The school shall implement flexible learning delivery modality, but not limited to Modular Distance Learning (MDL), Online Distance Learning or any other appropriate approach to ensure the continuity of instruction.

7. Co-curricular activities shall be conducted on class days, preferably after school hours. Schools have to reduce the standard time allotment for each learning area by up to ten (10) minutes once every two weeks, and the accumulated number of minutes shall be used for the conduct of any activity as stipulated in DO 012, s. 2025. A separate communication for this implementation shall be prepared.

8. The Class Program shall include Prepared by the Class Adviser, Noted by the School Head, Reviewed by the PSDIC, Recommending Approval by the ASDS, and Approved by the SDS.

7. This Office directs the immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum.
