### Meeting Schedule:

The DTCG-Multigrade will conduct bimonthly meetings, with the time and location set by the Chairperson. Notice of meetings will be provided at least one week in advance.

### 6. Budget:

The budget for the DTCG-Multigrade's activities will be sourced from Program Support Fund (PSF) and Division's Professional Development Fund. A detailed budget proposal will be submitted to the Division Superintendent for approval.
